- investigate how MFL can be linked to other areas of the curriculum
- demonstrate versatile strategies which allow pupils to manipulate a foreign language naturally
- encourage the transfer of good teaching practises from other areas of the curriculum to the delivery of Modern Languages and vice versa
- demonstrate how learning is accelerated through consideration of a multi intelligence approach to teaching
